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Sessions: 12 sessions for the season 2/2/12 to 4/26/12.

Times: Arrive for sessions EARLY, defaults will start 10-15 minutes after start time. Check in required when you arrive to participate. Most sessions are 7-9PM except for 1st session is 9-11P & 2nd @ Sat. 2/11/12 is 9AM-11AM. Rounds start at 15 minutes following session start and defaulted after 5 minutes. Defaults for matches not played can not be made up later in the session.

Dates: Thursday evenings. Except for session #2) Sat. 2/11/12 and #11) Wed 4/18/12

Location: AT & T Sports Pavilion Gym, 11051 O'Malley Centre Dr. (O'Malley & Old Seward Hwy)

Objective: Table Tennis action for fun, competition, variety and awards. All participants are expected to display good sportsmanship and respect for equipment and fellow players. League open to all skill levels, ages and abilities.

Awards: Trophies for top 3 finishers in each division. Door prizes at various sessions. End of Season Awards party in May for Most improved, Sportsmanship, Volunteers, Highest points winners in A, B & C level.

Points: Awarded for attendance for each session with a minimum of 2 matches played. Top finishers each session awarded additional points. Points awarded for each session and results 1st-8th in each division/session. Bonus points awarded for volunteering and sportsmanship. First session is an evaluation round and all attendees receive equal points regardless of results. If no show then no points.

Attendance: 20 points (**Double Points** are 2 times for both attendance & result points)

Plus additional points awarded each session:

50 points for 1st in each division, 40 points for 2nd, 35 points for 3rd, 30 points for 4th
25 points for 5th, 20 points for 6th, 15 points for 7th, 10 points for 8th

Bonus Points Awarded for player moving up or down a division, point value TBD.

Divisions: A, B & C. Approx 4-8 players in each division based on 14 to 24 total participants. Groups will vary based in daily attendance. Players may be move up or down divisions based on request by player and re-evaluation at intervals during season.

Format: Each session will have a different theme or event. Matches will vary from best 3 of 5, 2 out of 3 or 1 single game to 31 points. And others will be based on timed rounds. Events like skill division Singles, doubles, team, random doubles, handicap, timed round singles, hardbat and more. Hardbats provided if players do not have their own. Team events are 2 person.

Participation: Limited to max 24 PLAYERS for each session. Players grouped in 1-4 divisions for each session. Drop-in and 1/2 season special is limited to space available based on 8 tables.

Registration Cost:

Full season: (7-12 sessions) \$125.

Half season: (limited avail up to 3/31/12 for, 6 sessions) \$89.

Single session Drop-in (space available) \$14. (credit toward up to 2 paid single sessions \$14x2=\$28 to full season only. No credit toward half season)

Equipment: Tables, nets, balls, score equipment provided. Players should provide their own rackets but club paddles are available. On Hardbat session bring your own & some will be available for use.
